

Applicants must meet specific criteria.

**Criteria:**

1. Must be a **Duval County** resident and **cannot** be homeless
2. Must **not** have any medical or dental insurance, including Medicaid.
3. Family income must not exceed the following for each service:

**Medical**

Family Size	200% Poverty Monthly Threshold
1	\$1,962
2	\$2,655
3	\$3,348
4	\$4,042
5	\$4,735
6	\$5,428
For each additional person, add	\$693

**Dental**

Family Size	150% Poverty Monthly Threshold
1	\$1,471
2	\$1,991
3	\$2,511
4	\$3,031
5	\$3,551
6	\$4,071
For each additional person, add	\$520

**Please note the following:**

- 1) **Dental services are limited to extractions, filings and some restoration.**
- 2) We **DO NOT** provide dental hygiene, crowns, bridges or denture repair
- 3) **We are only providing care to adults age 18 and older.**

If you meet the above criteria, you can print a pre-qualification questionnaire or pick one up at our office. Complete and return with 4 weeks proof of income, if unemployed must submit a notarize letter of support
